What does it cost?

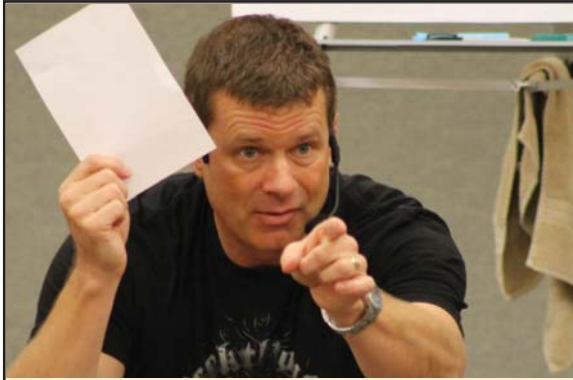
- \$265/student + \$170/cooperative
